NSSL acquires TET satellite solutions



NSSL, an international satellite communications provider headquartered in Redhill, Surrey, has acquired a satellite system integrator, TET Satellite Solutions (TET).

Following the acquisition TET Satellite Solutions will change its name to e-Go Solutions and continue to operate under the directorship of Peter Crafter as a fully owned subsidiary of NSSL.

NSSL said that the combined firm will create an enhanced customer offering for both marine and land satellite communications (satcom) solutions.

E-Go Solutions will focus on delivering solutions to the corporate market, including the finance, mining, construction and pharmaceutical sectors. NSSL will continue to provide comprehensive communication systems to its traditional customers in the maritime, media, oil and gas and government sectors.

Bob Chewter, managing director of NSSL, said: "This acquisition is a natural extension of the partnership that has existed between NSSL and TET since 2002, when the e-Go Solutions brand was established to launch our first IP-based product, RBGAN. In that time the e-Go Solutions brand has become one of the strongest in the sector and a closer union between the companies can only enhance that position."

The last year has seen the expansion of E-Go Solutions portfolio to include fixed, vehicular, and deployable broadband solutions, alongside a series of Voice-over IP (VoIP) and hand-held voice systems.

Peter Crafter, managing director of E-Go Solutions said: "E-Go Solutions has already seen the benefits of this acquisition, and following the launch of Inmarsat BGAN service we have enhanced our service offering and expanded our business to both new market sectors and new regions."
